

TOWN OF HANLEY
BYLAW 6/21
A BYLAW TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN
VEHICLES ON ROADWAYS WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS

The council for the Town of Hanley in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "ATV Bylaw".
2. In this Bylaw:
 - a. "All Terrain Vehicle" means all terrain vehicles as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act.
3. Under section 9 of the All Terrain Vehicles Act, all terrain vehicles shall be permitted to operate on the travelled portion of the whole or any part of a roadway within the Town of Hanley subject to the following condition:
 - a. The operator is in the act of taking the most direct route to or from his point of origin or destination within the Town of Hanley to or from the Town of Hanley corporate limits.
4. The operator of an all terrain vehicle must have a valid driver's license.
5. The owner of said all terrain vehicle must have insurance on the all terrain vehicle as per Section 14 the All Terrain Vehicle Act.
6. That Bylaw No. 16/13 be hereby repealed.
