## BYLAW NO. 2/22

### A BYLAW TO ADOPT DEVELOPMENT PERMIT FEES

The Council of the Town of Hanley, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. An applicant for a development permit shall pay an application processing fee in accordance with the following:

a) Residential:

i) permitted principal use	\$15.00
ii) permitted accessory use	\$ 0.00
iii) ancillary use	\$ 0.00
iv) discretionary principal use	\$15.00
v) discretionary accessory use	\$ 0.00
vi) minor variance	\$15.00

b) Commercial:

i) permitted principal use	\$30.00
ii) permitted accessory use	\$ 0.00
iii) ancillary use	\$ 0.00
iv) discretionary principal use	\$30.00
v) discretionary accessory use	\$ 0.00
vi) minor variance	\$30.00

c) Development appeal fee up to \$50.00 as specified by the Board

d) in addition, if a building permit is required, any fees associated with the issuance of a permit and inspection of construction related to a building permit.

2. This Bylaw comes into force and effect on the date of final approval by Council of the Town of Hanley.

3. Bylaw No. 9/16 is hereby repealed.
