

## BYLAW NO 18/19

### **A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HANLEY TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OTHER MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC UTILITY BOARD PURSUANT TO *THE MUNICIPALITIES ACT***

The Council of the Town of Hanley, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

#### 1. DEFINITIONS

In this bylaw:

- a) "Council" means the council of the Town of Hanley;
- b) "Public Utility Board" means the Dundurn Rural Water Utility, a body corporate established pursuant to Section 33 of *The Municipalities Act* by the municipalities as defined in section 3 of this Bylaw;
- c) "Board" means the Board of Directors of the Public Utility Board;

#### 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bylaw is to enable the council to enter an agreement with neighbouring municipalities to establish a Public Utility Board.

#### 3. MUNICIPAL MEMBERSHIP ON PUBLIC UTILITY BOARD

- a) The Town of Hanley is hereby authorized to create a public utility board in conjunction with the following municipalities:
  - Rural Municipality of Dundurn #314
  - Rural Municipality of Rosedale #283
  - Rural Municipality of Blucher #343
  - Town of Dundurn
  - Resort Village of Shields
  - Resort Village of Thode
- b) The public utility board created pursuant to subsection 2(a) shall be known as Dundurn Rural Water Utility.

#### 4. APPOINTMENT TO BOARD

The council shall appoint one Director to the Board.

5. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

The terms of the agreement are defined in the corporate bylaw of the Dundurn Rural Water Utility, which is identified as Schedule "A" and is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.


6. REPEAL

That Bylaw No. 1/14 be hereby repealed.
