

BYLAW NO. 13/19

TOWN OF HANLEY

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH GENERAL PENALTY

The Council of the Town of Hanley in the Province of Saskatchewan under the provision of *The Municipalities Act*, enacts as follows:


1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the Town of Hanley.
2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the Town of Hanley for which no other fine is provided and which, such bylaw states, shall incur the fines herein provided.
3. Fines, unless otherwise noted in a bylaw, will be as follows:

First infraction fine	\$100.00
Second infraction fine	\$200.00
Third Infraction and subsequent infractions	\$500.00 each up to the maximum
4. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any person found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality is liable to a fine of not more than;
 - a) \$10,000 in the case of an Individual
 - b) \$25,000 in the case of a Corporation
5. Bylaw 4/85 is hereby repealed.
