BYLAW NO. 12/21

TOWN OF HANLEY

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS ON PUBLIC ROADWAYS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF HANLEY

The council for the Town of Hanley in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Short Title:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Golf Cart Bylaw".

Definitions:

2. "Golf Cart" as prescribed in the Traffic Safety Act.

Regulations:

- 3. Persons operating a golf cart must be using the cart for the sole purpose of travelling to/from the golf course using the shortest, most direct route between the golf course and where the golf cart is stored.
- 4. No one shall operate a golf cart on a public roadway within the limits of the Town of Hanley without a valid class 7 driver's licence, abiding by all Saskatchewan Government Insurance regulations and requirements.
- 5. Owners must carry third-party liability insurance and all personal and public liability will be the responsibility of the operator of the golf cart.
- 6. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$25.00.
- 7. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval thereof by Saskatchewan Government Insurance.
