A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 1/2006 BEING A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR
THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES

Dear Sir/Madam:

This letter is formal notice that the above-mentioned properties are in contravention of Bylaw 1/2006, a Bylaw to Provide for the Abatement of Nuisances as indicated below:

- ___ Dilapidated Building/Structure (Section 6)
- ___ Unoccupied Building damaged or deteriorated (Section 7)
- ___ Overgrown Grass and Weeds (Section 8, 9 & 10)
- ___ Untidy or unsightly yard (Section 11)
- ___ Junked Vehicles – rusted, wrecked, partly wrecked, dismantled, inoperative or abandoned (not within a structure) (Section 12 amended by Bylaw No.11/19 Section 3.e)ii))
- ___ Open Excavation (Section 13)
- ___ Maintenance of Yards – infestation of rodents, vermin or insects; dead or hazardous trees; sharp or dangerous objects (Section 14)
- ___ Outdoor Storage of Materials – not stacked in piles and elevated off the ground (Section 15)
- ___ Appliances (Section 16)
- ___ Fences (Section 17)

Pursuant to this bylaw, the Town of Hanley has authority to take whatever actions or measures are necessary to remedy a contravention.

Please address the violation within 30 days of receipt of this letter.

The Town would like to achieve compliance by working with you. However, if the violation continues, the municipality will issue an order for the cleanup of the property with the unpaid charges for the service added to the taxes of the property. You have 30 days to remedy this notice or 15 days to appeal. Please call the Town Office at 306-544-2223 prior to the deadline if you would like to discuss a remedy or to appeal this order.
