

**A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 11/09 BEING A BYLAW TO PROVIDE
FOR ENTERING INTO AGREEMENT AND SETTING POLICIES AND
PROCEDURES FOR A WASTE TRANSFER STATION**

The Council for the Town of Hanley, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) That Bylaw No. 11/09 be amended by deleting section 3 and by substituting the following:
- 2) a. Containers for reception of garbage shall be kept in the bins supplied by the municipality.
b. A person disposing of construction waste, including shingles, shall make arrangements with either:
(i) the Town of Hanley for a 6-yard construction bin for small projects more specifically defined as:
Garages, sheds, decks, patios, and basement developments; or
(ii) a waste contractor for a larger construction bin.
c. A delivery charge of fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be payable to the Town of Hanley following the removal of the 6-yard construction bin back to the storage yard.
d. The fee for emptying the container shall be as invoiced by the Loraas Disposal agreement including the fuel surcharge and shall be payable to the Town of Hanley
e. A weekly charge of \$50 and/or monthly charge of \$200 shall be applicable for long-term usage of containers.
- 3) Bylaw No. 14/13 be hereby repealed.
