MISSING FROM THE AG FAIR





HANLEY AG FAIR

The Hanley Agricultural Fair was held on Friday August 27th and Saturday August 28th at the Hanley Sports grounds. The fair was the first one since Hanley's Homecoming in 2005. The fair was hosted and organized by the Hanley Agricultural Society.

The fair was kicked off on Friday Night by a Hanley Merchants Reunion Game that was played by Merchants past and present. There was a huge crowd support for the game with over 100 people in attendance. There was a beer gardens that was followed up by an evening of Karaoke singing in the Prairie Palace located at the sports grounds. The karaoke was provided by Colleen Carr. There were many singers that showcased their talents throughout the night, which continued on till early hours of the morning!

Saturday morning was started bright and early with a Pancake breakfast hosted by the Hanley Ag Society, in which pancakes and ham was served to a hungry crowd of approximately 125 people. The slow-pitch tournament fired up at 9:30am with 10 teams entered and was played all day long. The final four teams were 1st -The Fat Kids, 2nd- Mound Pounders, 3rd - Barrington Bears, 4th - Amanda Anderson's Team. All teams put forth a great effort and all games were played with great sportsmanship. The bike parade was a huge success, as well, having over 28 kids entered with their bikes, strollers, wagons and mini quads of all kinds decorated. They took a tour around the ball field to display their works of art. First place was awarded to Hunter Matycio. Great job Hunter! Madison Prosofsky and Kennedy Dietz set up a face painting station that was a very popular spot for the young ones, resulting in some fantastic looking bugs and animals and flowers that decorated the young ones' faces! Brenda from Dundurn brought a whole array of animals in for the petting zoo, which the kids young and old enjoyed! There were rabbits, snakes, a miniature horse, momma goat with her twin babies, potbellied pig, chickens and chicks and a miniature pincher puppy. The kids were able to be in and interact with the animals which displayed wonderful temperaments while letting the children feed and handle them. The money pit filled with coins and toys was a constant construction site for the kids as well, keeping them all occupied and their pockets full of treat money!! The beer gardens were open all day long and a delicious beef on a bun dinner was served by the culture club who was in charge of the concession booth for the weekend. The evening entertainment was provided by a local DJ named Patrick who owns and operates Partie Sound DJ Services out of Saskatoon. He kept the crowd going all night! There were over 320 people that came through the gates on Saturday to enjoy the festivities. You will be able to do this from your own home computer as well as the librarian. The site is www.wheatland.sk.ca. Also you will now be able to create a list that shows all the books you have read since the new SILS system has been installed. You just need to turn the list on from your home computer; the library does not have access to this as it is a privacy issue. The most important thing residents need to remember is that library patrons will not be able to take out material from the library without their library card, so you'll need to carry this with you whenever coming to the library.


